FREE CLASSES FOR CHILDREN UP TO AGE 5

The School Districts within SAU 7 are offering READY! for Kindergarten classes for parents who have children newborn to age 5. This program shares information about the lively early-learning years before a child enters school, which lays the foundation for all future learning. Included in each training session are a collection of FREE toys, activities and/or books for parents to bring home and use with their child(ren).

Classes are free to families residing in SAU 7 (Columbia, Colebrook, Stewartstown, Clarksville and Pittsburg), and free child care is provided. Infants under the age of one at-

tend classes with their parents. Parents pick one class to attend based on the age of their child. There are three READY! Sessions that will be held between now and September 2012. Each session targets different skills. Attendance at all three sessions is highly encouraged. And, because some of your families have more than one child, you may want to attend more than one night in each session. Our assistant will help you pick the night(s) that work best for you. The first READY! classes for the first session will be offered on Tuesday, May 22, 2012 at the Stewartstown Community School; Thursday, May 24, 2012 at the Colebrook Elementary School; and Wednesday, May

30, 2012 at the Pittsburg School. All first-time attendees are required to attend orientation from 5:30-6 p.m. where they will receive their READY! notebook and other materials. READY! classes will immediately follow orientation from 6-7:30 p.m.

Registration for READY! classes will open on Wednesday, May 2, 2012.
